Heads-up on 100% funded Apprenticeship Opportunities

Raising Awareness

The LEPs Apprenticeship Levy Transfer service relaunched on 28 September 2020. The service will help businesses and training providers to work together to make a positive difference to the economic recovery through ensuring vital apprenticeship opportunities are available to people across the Leeds City Region. This a **free** transfer service which covers 100% of the training costs for apprentices. Businesses can still claim government grants whilst accessing the Levy. The LEP are having discussions with Levy payers (with a wage bill over £3m) regarding pledging up to 25% of their unspent Levy allocation to support businesses across the Leeds City Region. Companies who are not levy payers can also be considered for the funding.

The role of the LEP

Who is it for?

A levy transfer can be made to businesses based in Bradford, Calderdale, Kirklees, Leeds, Wakefield or York. The transfer covers 100% of the training costs of an apprenticeship only, this could be newly-hired apprentices or existing employers who would benefit from development and a formal qualification.
